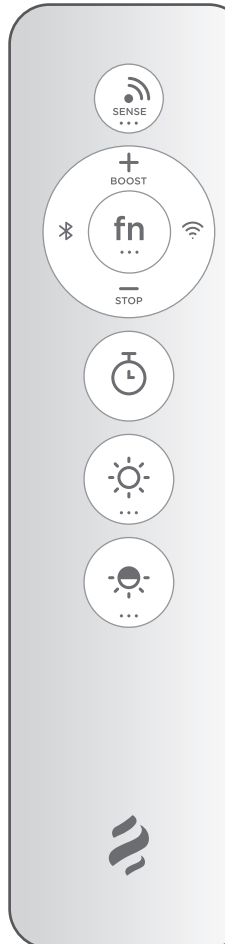
**BATTERIA**

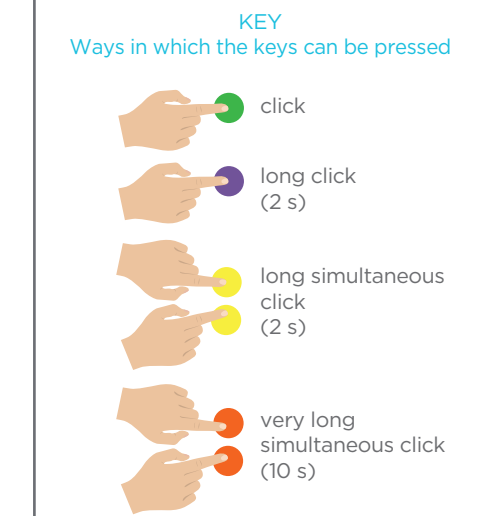
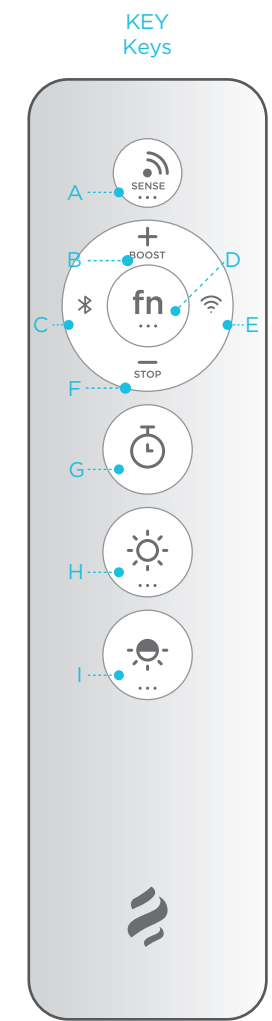

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAFE OPERATION OF THE REMOTE CONTROL

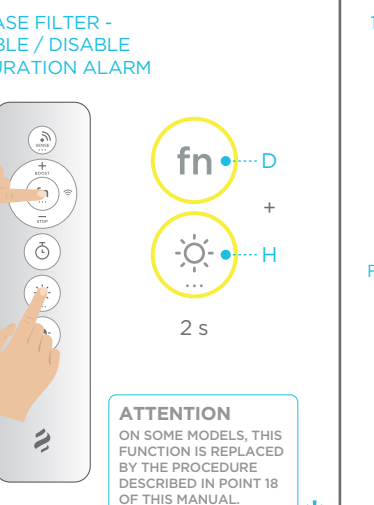
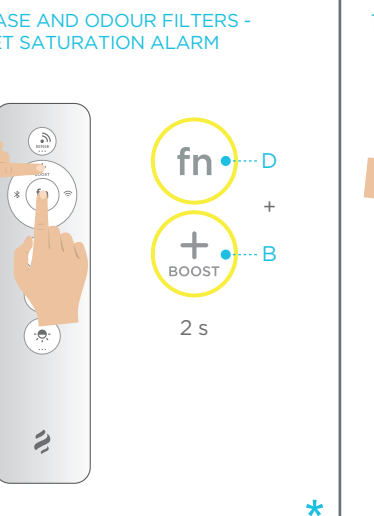
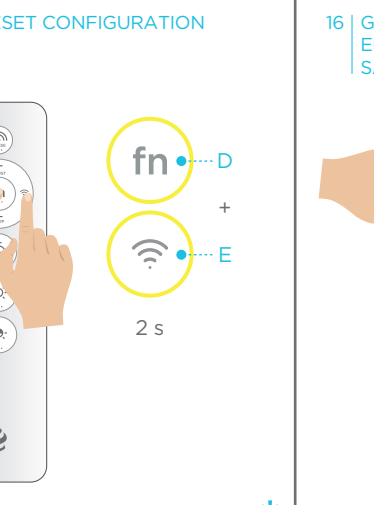
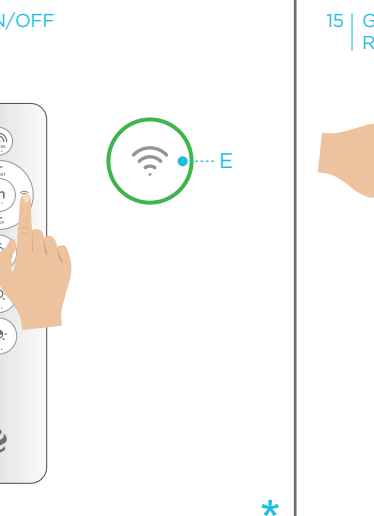
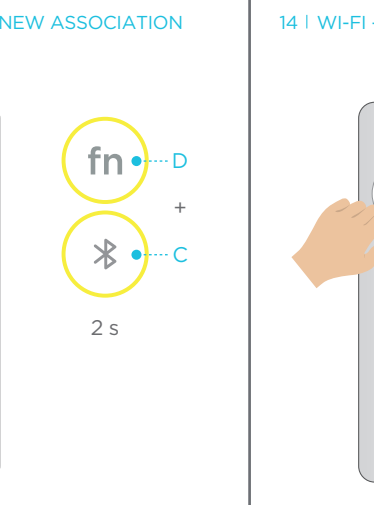
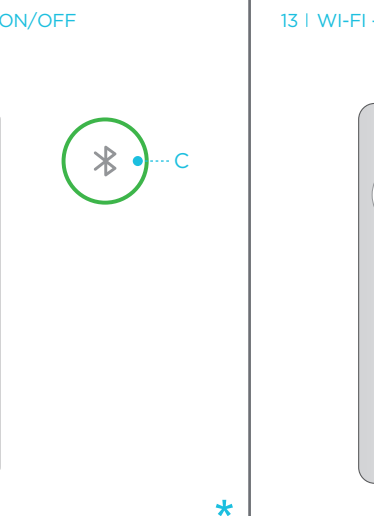
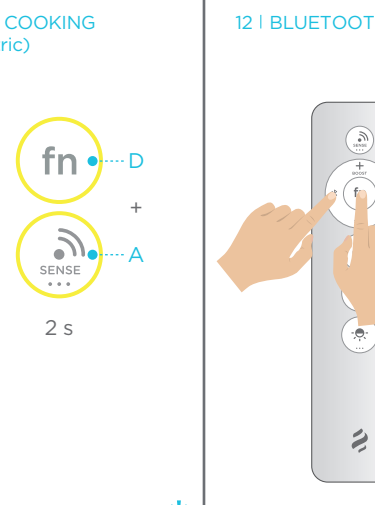
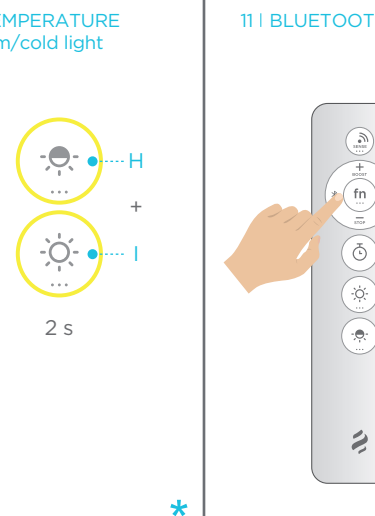
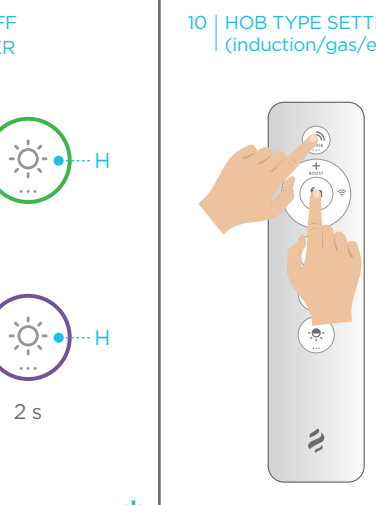
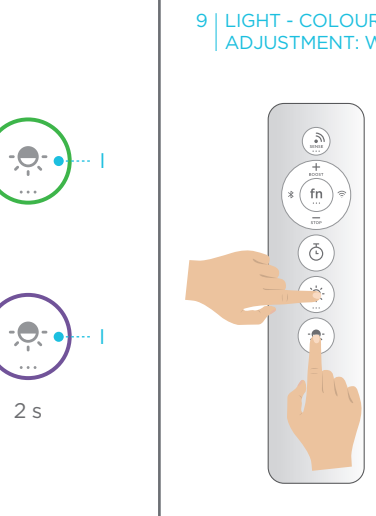
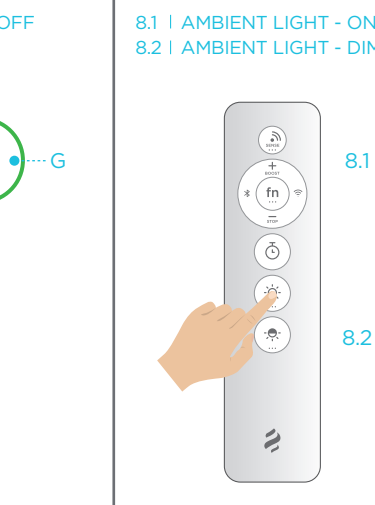
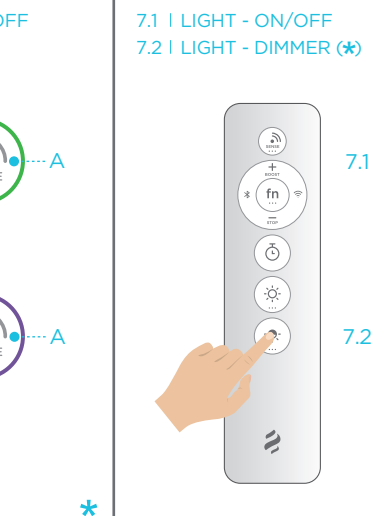
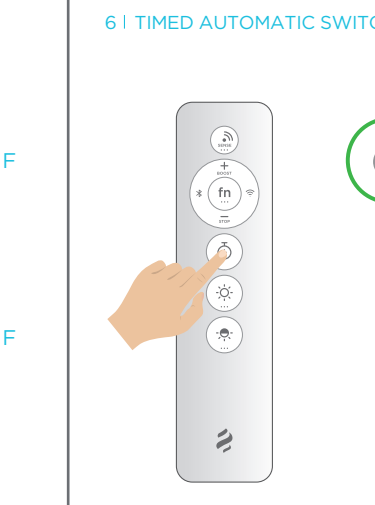
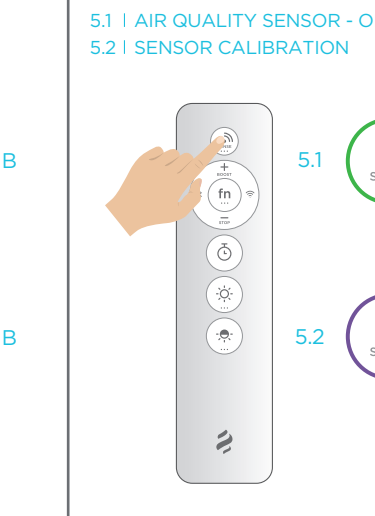
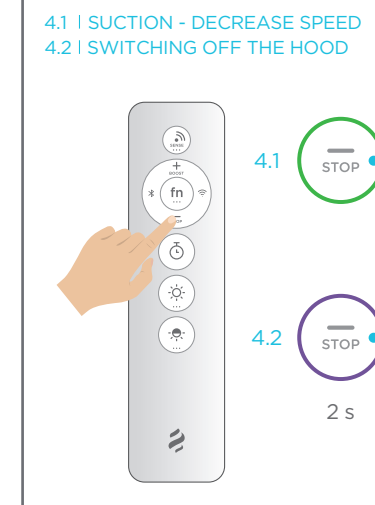
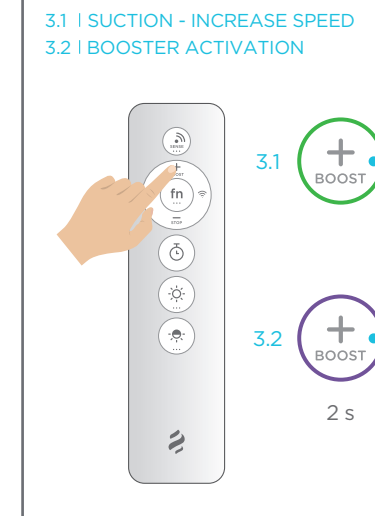
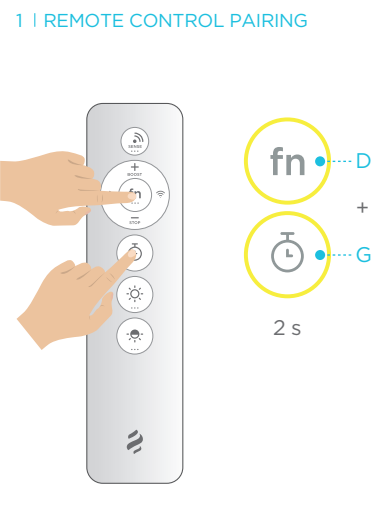
The remote control can be used by children who are younger than 8 years old and by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capacity, or without experience or the specific knowledge, as long as they are under surveillance or after they have received instructions regarding the safe use of the remote control and understand the dangers related to it. Children must not play with the remote control. The cleaning and maintenance that should be carried out by the user should not be done by unsupervised children.



**CAUTION!**  
To control the hood via remote control, the affiliation procedure must be carried out (see paragraph 1)

**IF THERE IS MALFUNCTION**  
Follow the procedure for a new code allocation (see paragraph 2). Then disconnect and reconnect the hood to the power supply. Repeat the affiliation procedure (see paragraph 1).
